A William IV period, mahogany console or fold-over tea table, Circa 1835. This table with well figured solid mahogany oblong top with square corners and bevelled edge. The top folds out and swivels around to reveal a square top. Inside is a green baize lined cavity. A flame mahogany frieze. Supported on a hexagonal stem on circular base, raised carved claw feet, all with internal castors. A high quality, original table, very well presented, and in very good condition. Cleaned and wax polished, and very much ready for use. Dimensions: This table measures approximately 75 cm (29.5") tall, 90.5 cm (35.5") wide, 48 cm (19") deep at the widest point across the base. The top measures approximately 90 cm (35.5") by 89 cm (35") when folded out. Condition: Please see the pictures for details of the items condition. - This table is in very good condition, commensurate with its age, and is structurally sound and sturdy. Only minor odd marks and blemishes. Cleaned and wax polished. Ready for use. - As with all vintage & antique furniture there will be signs of use, marks, wear & tear, etc.

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
