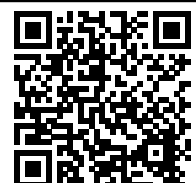

Formed to represent slippers, they are beautifully engraved with acanthus details and are linked together by a chain. Needle guards were used when knitting needles had points at both ends, to prevent the stitches from sliding off. These wonderful collector's items are of Austro/Hungarian origin and are a great collector's item, both decorative and practical. Dimensions below.
