## Description

Flight, Barr and Barr Worcester porcelain vase, c. 1815. Painted in the manner of Thomas Baxter, with a youth, playing a harp before rocks, in a landscape. The reverse with a band of stylised acanthus and scrollwork in gilt, above an Apple green ground. A band of gilt bells, hanging from scroll work adorn the inner rim. The vase having gilt ring handles, suspended from eagles beaks, dividing a band of beadwork, and set upon a square pedestal foot. Titled in red script 'The Minstrel', 'The wild harp rang to his adventurous hand.' Red script factory mark, and addresses. Height – 9 cm, 3 1/2". Diameter – 7.5 cm, 3". Condition – Repair to small chip to one gilt beak. Typical minor wear to the gilding – please see images for detail.
