An incredibly impressively vintage diamond cluster ring. The centre stone is modified old European cut which weighs 1.40 carat but spreads to the size of a 2.00 carat stone. Ten further old European cuts surround the centre stone in a platinum coronet settings, with very pretty ornamental detailing in the under gallery. On a slim and flat platinum shank. A wonderfully sparkly vintage treasure. Accompanied by an independent jewellery report from IGR (#30310344). Cut – Old European cut diamonds. Colour – J in the centre, with F to J. Clarity – VS2 in the centre, VS2 to SI1 in the surround. Carat – The centre stone is a known 1.40 carat, with a further approximate 1.20 carat in the surround. Circa – 1910. Size – M (UK) or 6 (US). Complimentary sizing is available, can be sized up or down. Measurements – The centre stone is approximately 8.05 carat in diameter. The head of the ring is approximately 15.1mm in diameter. Sits 8.2mm from the finger. Metal – Platinum. Tested.
